

5-Year/60,000-Mile Bumper-to-Bumper

New Vehicle Limited Warranty

Note: Applies to all new 2004, 2004.5 and 2005 model-year vehicles sold on or after July 1, 2004.

This **Mitsubishi 5-year/60,000-mile Bumper-to-Bumper** New Vehicle Limited Warranty extends the original 3-year or 36,000-mile (whichever occurs first) Basic New Vehicle Limited Warranty for an additional 2 years or 24,000 miles (whichever occurs first) to 5 years or 60,000 miles (whichever occurs first) from the original in-service date.

This is a continuation of the original Basic New Vehicle Limited Warranty and extends all warranty coverage (except as stated below) in effect at the end of the original New Vehicle Limited Warranty. In addition, this warranty extension includes the same exceptions (such as items and conditions not covered), in the original Basic New Vehicle Limited Warranty.

This warranty is fully transferable to subsequent owners at no charge.

For complete information on items and conditions not covered by this warranty, see the Owner's Warranty and Maintenance booklet for details.

COVERAGE AND TERM

For the first 5 years or 60,000 miles, whichever occurs first, any part of this vehicle supplied by Mitsubishi Motors (except batteries and items or conditions listed in the New Vehicle Limited Warranty under the headings "OTHERS" and "WHAT IS NOT COVERED"), which proves defective in normal use will be repaired or replaced by any Authorized Mitsubishi Motors Retailer or Authorized Service Center, using new or remanufactured Authorized Mitsubishi Motors parts.

Additional excluded items that are covered only for the original 3-year/36,000-mile warranty period are:

- Audio Components – (CD and DVD Players)
- Bulbs

NOTE: Aftermarket parts or accessories not authorized and supplied by Mitsubishi Motors are NOT covered by this warranty.

WARRANTY START DATE

This warranty starts on the date of original retail delivery or original use, whichever occurs first. The additional years and/or months or 24,000 miles of coverage is based on the original in-service date and actual odometer mileage of the vehicle. The "original in-service date" is defined as the date of original retail delivery or date of first use, whichever occurred first. The date of record on file with Mitsubishi shall constitute the official in-service date.

OBTAINING WARRANTY SERVICE

To obtain warranty service, you must return your vehicle to any Authorized Mitsubishi Motors Retailer or Authorized Service Center where such service will be performed without charge for parts and/or labor.
